

Thoughts for Addition/Renovation

- APS will ask for McKinley Reps through principal – be very open on how you select these
 - o We did call for nominations and the selection on a criteria that best represented the different neighborhoods
- Ensure that each neighborhood association that feeds McKinley has rep(s)
- Meet with non-county and APS staff BLPC members and school staff members prior to start to get have a sense of your priorities
- Present and work with neighborhood associations – attend their meetings - school and APS
 - o We did not do this and it is what hurt us
- Include link to APS and info on project on School Web site
- Explain the process to community – BLPC – PFRC – APS approval several times, All the county input and then their approval for permits – Have APS outline the entire process up front – incredibly complex and I am not sure I understand it all
- Have PTA meetings for input
 - o We had 4 with APS and Design coming twice to speak and still concerns
- Select a BLPC communications person
 - o Send email inviting community to each BLPC – observe only but invite to share thoughts with BLPC members
 - o Send email with link to web for presentation and minutes after each meeting
 - o Get minutes from A/E (they should be doing this) and share minutes and presentations on web site along with community
